### **Position Description**

#### **Title: Part-time Environmental Educator 1**

**Background:** the Watsonville Wetlands Watch (WWW), a non-profit organization dedicated to protecting, restoring, and fostering the appreciation of the wetlands of the Pájaro Valley, seeks several on-call Environmental Educators to assist in leading hands-on wetland-based programming. Preferred candidates will have a college degree or be pursuing a degree related to environmental science and/or studies and have a background in outdoor teaching.

Watsonville Wetlands Watch provides a fun and supportive work environment and we are looking for team players who are creative, passionate about the environment and love working with youth ages 10-18. We provide outdoor education for students of the Pájaro Valley Unified School District intermittently throughout the school year during the school day and after school. We are looking for educators with flexible schedules who are willing to help teach in the classroom and on field trips to the Watsonville wetlands on an on-call basis. Activities generally last about 2-3 hours and cover themes including water quality, habitats, biodiversity, food webs, and wetland ecology. Educators are expected to attend paid trainings and help with the set up and clean up of activities. They will also be required to get fingerprinted through the Pájaro Valley Unified School District.

Compensation is \$50 per field trip (usually about 2 hours).
