Position Overview:

Watsonville Wetlands Watch is a mission driven non-profit organization dedicated to protecting, restoring, and fostering an appreciation of the wetlands of the Pajaro Valley. WWW seeks an Environmental Educator to facilitate outdoor wetland-based activities for youth of the Pajaro Valley and coordinate citizen science data collection to monitor the health of the Watsonville wetland system. Watsonville Wetlands Watch provides a fun and supportive work environment and we are looking for a team player who is passionate about the environment and loves working with children and volunteers.

The ideal candidate will have experience providing environmental education to 3rd-12th grade youth, experience in field data collection, experience working with volunteers, and a background in wetland ecology. Desired qualifications include; bilingual in Spanish and English, a bachelor's degree in an environmentally-related field, GIS mapping experience, excellent organization and teaching skills, and the ability to take initiative and work independently.

Duties will include training and supervising teen staff and volunteers, leading activities at school sites, leading field trips to the Watsonville wetlands, coordinating water quality sampling, coordinating bird population counts, participating in weekend outreach events, and maintaining program files. This position requires own transportation with insurance and must be able to drive a minimum of three students to field trip sites.

This is a part-time 20-24 hours/week position with occasional weekend work. Hourly pay range is \$16.00 - \$19.00/hour with prorated medical benefits and an employer sponsored retirement match program.
